Cumberland Energy Authority hosting the 2nd Annual Energy Symposium

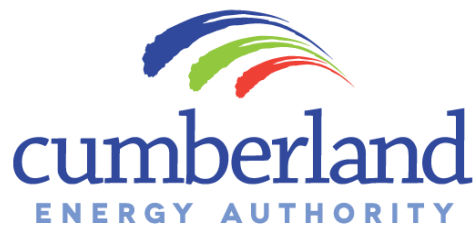
The Cumberland Energy Authority is hosting the 2nd Annual Energy Symposium in Springhill, Nova Scotia on September 22 and 23, 2016. This FREE two day event is open to the public and will showcase renewable energy initiatives and research projects by developers, academia, and organizations from across the province in hopes of gaining greater insight into Cumberland County's renewable energy sector.

Finally, a Tourism Evening will be available to all registrants on Thursday, September 22. This event will consist of a tour of the Fundy Ocean Research Centre for Energy to hear from leading experts in the tidal energy sector, as well as an Open House event hosted by Black Rock Tidal Power. Last year's Symposium saw approximately 300 developers, energy organizations, academia, various levels of government, and high school students attend the three event.
