Contaminated Clothing Policy 08-02

General

1. This policy is entitled “Contaminated Clothing Policy”
2. This policy shall apply to all employees at the Municipality of the County of Cumberland that work in biological contaminated working conditions. This policy pertains to Public Works outside staff as well as By-law Enforcement.
3. It is required by the Municipality of the County of Cumberland to provide a procedure under the Occupational Safety General Regulations Act subsection 22(2) amended. OIC-2000-130, NS Reg. 52/2000.
4. This policy shall be administered by Department supervisors.

Initiation of Clothing Cleaning

- 5 a) Work clothes that are exposed to any containment such as sewage, garbage and other materials which may pose a health risk will be laundered at the Municipality’s expense.
- b) Personal clothing will also be included under this policy if contaminated.

Transportation

- 6 a) Each department will be solely responsible for delivery and pickup of clothing to and from a local laundry facility.

Historical Data:

- 7 a) Approximate usage for clothing cleaning would be 4 times annually unless exposed to extreme conditions.

Quotation:

- 8 a) A minimum of two quotes are required biannually for provision of service.

The Municipality will supply the following clothing for each employee working with contaminated material.

- 9 a) three pair of coveralls, one being insulated.

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These clothes will be laundered on as needed basis to be determined by the immediate supervision of the department.
