

Schedule “A” of the Septage Disposal By-Law
Septage Treatment Facility – Fees and Service Area

Licensing Fee

1. The annual licensing fee for a licensed domestic septage disposer is \$50.

Septic Waste Disposal Fees

2. Septage (as defined) collected from properties within the Service Area may be disposed of at the Little Forks Septage Treatment Facility at no cost by a licensed septic disposer.

Service Area

3. Little Forks septage treatment facility will receive domestic septage collected within the area contained within the municipal boundaries of the Municipality of Cumberland County, which excludes the Towns of Amherst, Oxford, Springhill and Parrsboro.
