

Municipality of Cumberland Equipment Loan Program

The Municipality of Cumberland Equipment Loan Program provides access to safe, well-maintained equipment for physical activity and recreation. Equipment can be borrowed for up to two (2) weeks unless other arrangements have been approved. Equipment availability depends on demand and program needs. Equipment pick-up, drop-off, and storage are coordinated through the Municipality of Cumberland.

Equipment may be picked up and returned at one of the following locations:

- Parrsboro Service Centre, Parrsboro
- Dr. Carson & Marion Murray Community Centre, Springhill
- Upper Nappan Service Centre, Upper Nappan
- Pugwash Service Centre, Pugwash

User Rights and Responsibilities

1. You must provide accurate contact information on the Equipment Loan Registration Form.
2. You are responsible for taking care of the equipment while it is borrowed.
3. You must store the equipment safely and use it properly.
4. You must report any loss, damage, safety concerns, or equipment problems to the Municipality as soon as possible.
5. You must follow all safety instructions and applicable laws while using the equipment.
6. Equipment must only be used for its intended purpose.
7. You must contact the Active Living Coordinator to arrange equipment pick-up and return.
8. You are responsible for transporting the equipment to and from the approved pick-up and drop-off location.
9. Misuse of equipment may result in the loss of borrowing privileges and/or responsibility for repair or replacement costs.

Municipality Rights and Responsibilities

1. The Municipality is responsible for distributing, collecting, maintaining, and storing the equipment.
2. The Municipality will make reasonable efforts to keep equipment in good working condition.
3. The Municipality may change borrowing periods or lending conditions based on equipment availability, program needs, or other circumstances.
4. The Municipality may suspend or remove borrowing privileges if equipment is damaged, misused, lost, or not returned as agreed.
5. The Municipality may require users to pay for repair or replacement costs if equipment is damaged, lost, or destroyed while on loan.
