

# You're Invited!

The Municipality of the County of Cumberland is currently developing a Community Energy and Emissions Plan (CEEP). A CEEP will create a roadmap for the Municipality and community to further address climate change through greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reductions. The CEEP will be a strategic plan to guide the community in reducing its consumption of energy from sources which release GHG emissions into the atmosphere, contributing to climate change. Ultimately, the plan will help the community become more energy-independent, resilient, and sustainable, and reduce the contribution to the effects of climate change.

The CEEP Plan will include four key parts:

1. Corporate and community GHG emission inventory
2. Emission reduction targets for the years 2030 and 2050
3. Strategies for meeting the proposed GHG targets
4. A monitoring framework to track progress

As part of the CEEP process, gathering input from a variety of individuals will be essential in the emissions and policy analysis and the development of new GHG emission reductions for 2030 and 2050.
