To All Bidders of RFP-MCC-2320:

Please note: the following addendum applies to RFP-MCC-2320 and shall be taken into consideration when preparing bid documents.

1. Would it be possible to provide a map showing the start and end locations of the project, the RFP mentions 2.2km of road but also indicates the project is from the Cape d'Or Light House parking lot to Horseshoe cove which is approximately 1.5km.

A map has been provided in Addendum #2.

2. Construction admin is not included in the scope of work however item **20. Safety** indicates that the consultant is responsible for construction site safety. Could this item be clarified or removed if not required?

Contractor will not be responsibility for construction site if they are not providing construction admin services. This reference to "responsible for construction site safety" can be removed.

3. "Storm water and waterway course management" is included in the project scope of work however there is no indication of the number of watercourses within the project area. Will identifying watercourses and Habitats be the responsibility of the consultant?

Yes.

4. Will replacement of all cross culverts be included in the scope of work? If yes could the location and size of the culverts included be identified?

Cross culverts are necessary components of the storm water and watercourse management. If cross culverts are found to be undersized, poorly located, or in poor condition during site investigation. The Municipality does not have an inventory of the existing cross culverts.

5. “the proponent will be responsible for obtaining permitting required for culverts at watercourses” can this be removed, permitting for the replacement of culverts should be the responsibility of the contractor.

In order to facilitate the most expedient construction schedule the Consultants shall provide the documents and design work necessary to obtain water course alteration permits from Nova Scotia Environment if required. The Municipality will be the permit applicant.

6. The due date for the proposal is November 24th, in order to allow adequate time to receive responses on the above questions as well as to provide time to contact the subconsultants that will be required for this project, would it be possible to extend the submission date for proposals?

Please note an extension of the closing date to December 1, 2023 at 2PM.
