The Outdoor Adventurers Program encourages children to be outdoors and active throughout the summer months, while having fun and making new friends! These summer day-camps run Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for ages 5 to 12. Age 5 must have completed a minimum of pre-primary to participate.

Cost: \$35 for weeks 1 to 4 and 6 to 7, \$25 for week 5. There is a \$5 discount per additional child, per week within the same household.

The Municipality of Cumberland Department of Recreation & Community Services is committed to providing a positive, engaging recreation experience for all participants. To achieve this goal, we expect participants to show respect and consideration for staff and fellow participants, be cooperative and engage in activities, respect programming rules, the facility and program equipment.

Our summer staff are carefully selected based on their past experiences, skills, enthusiasm, and their ability to work with children and participants of all ages. All our staff must attend mandatory training on topics such as leadership, motivation, teamwork, parent feedback, policies, and procedures, as well as specifics about programming and management expectations. All summer staff are certified in First Aid/CPR, HIGH FIVE Principles of Healthy Child Development, NCCP Fundamental Movements, Food Handlers and Duty To Report as well as Autism N.S. training.

We want you to know that your child is in a caring and safe environment. We ensure the safe supervision of all participants by monitoring and maintaining staff to participant ratios for the appropriate age group and by completing head counts throughout the day, from one transition to the next. We hope you enjoy a wonderful summer with us!
