

BY-LAW RE BOUNDARIES, TOWN OF PARRSBORO,
NOVA SCOTIA.

Upon reading the Petition dated August the Fourth, 1925, of Harvey Smith, Charles O'Neil, William Skidmore, J. Lenley Grant, Charles Faulkenham, D. D. Layton, Herbert Gibson, James Farrell, George Warren, Mrs. M. L. Chesley, and J. B. Canning, being two-thirds and more, of the owners of real property in the District proposed to be taken from the Town of Parrsboro, by the change of its Boundaries, hereinafter set forth, praying that the boundaries of the Town of Parrsboro be changed as hereinafter set forth, it was resolved that the prayer thereof be granted, and therefore it is ordained by the Council of the town of Parrsboro that the Boundaries of the Town of Parrsboro as fixed by Section 2, of Chapter 55 of the Statutes of Nova Scotia for the year 1884 are hereby altered and shall be as follows, that is to say:-

Beginning at the Bay Shore on the West Line of Lot No. 91, and thence running Northerly along said line and a prolongation thereof to the North line of the Pettis Grant so called; thence Easterly along said North line to the right bank of the Partridge Island River; thence down the said River following the right bank thereof to the south side of the Swan Creek Road so called; thence following the line heretofore regarded and acted upon as the Boundary Line of the said Town by the said Town and by the Municipality of the County of Cumberland, until it comes to the Bay Shore and thence along the shore of the Basin of Minas following the different courses thereof to the place of beginning.
