

BY-LAW CONCERNING AMUSEMENT OR CIRCUS ORGANIZATIONS OPERATING WITHIN THE TOWN

Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Town of Parrsboro as follows:

1. No person or corporation shall conduct or operate within the Town any circus or other itinerant amusement performance without having a license therefore which is in force.
 2. Such license shall be granted by the License Committee and when granted shall be issued and signed by the Town Clerk.
 3. Application for such license shall be made to the Town Clerk, who shall place such application before the License Committee.
 4. Such application shall be in writing and shall indicate upon what day or days it is desired that the license be in force; and it shall indicate whether it is in respect of a circus or of an itinerant amusement performance other than a circus; and if in respect of an itinerant amusement performance other than a circus, it shall indicate the number of amusement units making up such itinerant amusement performance and the nature of each.
 5. Such license shall indicate on the face thereof the day or days during which it is to be in force.
 6. The license fee in respect of a circus shall be \$50.00 for the first day and \$25.00 for each subsequent day.
 7. The license fee in respect of an itinerant amusement performance other than a circus shall be regulated as follows:
 - (a) For each merry-go-round, ferris wheel, whip, swings, loop-the-loop, or other amusement unit of like nature,
 - (i) for the first day \$20.00
 - (ii) for each subsequent day \$5.00
 - (b) For each amusement unit other than those mentioned in Clause (a).
 - (i) for the first day \$15.00
 - (ii) for each subsequent day \$5.00
- Provided that the minimum fee to be charged for any such license shall be \$20.00 for the first day and \$5.00

for each subsequent day and further provided that the maximum fee to be charged for any such license shall be \$25.00 for the first day and \$15.00 for each subsequent day.

8. Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this by-law shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$25.00, nor more than \$100.00, and in default of payment to be imprisoned for a term not exceeding 60 days, for each day they violate said Section.

9. Any corporation which violates the provisions of Section 1 of this by-law shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$25.00, and not more than \$100.00 for each day they violate said Section.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Parrsboro as follows:

That Section 8 of the By-law entitled "Respecting the Licensing of Circuses and other itinerant amusement performances under the authority of subsection 7I of Chapter 263 of the Towns' Incorporation Act, as that subsection is enacted by Chapter 29 of the Acts of 1936", be amended by striking therefrom the following words contained in the last line thereof "for each day they violate said section".

That Section 9 of said By-law be amended by striking therefrom the following words contained in the last line thereof "for each day they violate said section".
