

PARRSBORO BY-LAW IN RESPECT OF POLL TAX

AMENDMENT TO TOWN OF PARRSBORO BY-LAWS

CHAPTER 32 - POLL TAX.

Moved by Councillor Cameron, seconded by Councillor Crossman, that Chapter 32 of the Town of Parrsboro By-Laws in respect of Poll Tax, as provided for by Section 6, Chapter 86, the Assessment Act R.S.N.S. 1923; be amended and repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"Each and every male resident of the Town of Parrsboro between the ages of twenty-one and sixty years, who is not * assessed on real or personal property or income, in excess of \$200.00, shall pay into the Town Treasury an annual Poll Tax of Five Dollars".

Each and every male resident of the Town of Parrsboro between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one years, shall pay into the Town Treasury an annual Poll Tax of Two Dollars".

That the word "Assessed" contained in the third line of the first paragraph thereof, be struck out and the word "rated" substituted therefor; and the words "or income" contained in the same line and paragraph be struck out and omitted from the said By-Law.
