Moved by Mayor Smith (with Deputy Mayor Chambers in the Chair) seconded by Councillor Gillespie, and passed, that the following by-law be passed and adopted.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AS A BY-LAW.

"Any person desiring to erect a new building, or to repair the exterior of any old building, when the cost of such repairs or alterations exceeds the sum of Fifteen Dollars shall submit the plans and specifications of the proposed building, alterations or repairs, to the Inspector of Building whose duty it shall be to place the said plans and specifications with the report thereon, before the Town Council, and no person shall commence the erection of any new building, or the repair or alteration of any old building, when the cost of such repairs or alterations exceeds the sum of fifteen dollars, until the plans and specifications therefor have been approved by the Town Council".
