

RE CONDUCT IN PUBLIC PLACES

Amendment to Chapter ~~34~~¹⁴ of Town of Parrsboro By-Laws

In accordance with the notice given at the last meeting of the Council, Councillor Boyd moved that the By-laws of the Town of Parrsboro be amended by the addition of the following:

Chapter ~~34~~¹⁴, section 3A

"No person or persons shall act in a disorderly manner or cause a disturbance in or near any street, road, highway or public place, by swearing, shouting, screaming, singing, fighting, wrestling, loitering or use insulting language or be in an intoxicated condition, or annoy pedestrians, within the Town of Parrsboro."

This motion was seconded by Councillor L. M. Gillespie and passed unanimously.
