

BY-LAW RE GARAGES AND FILLING STATION

Moved by Councillor G. A. Gillespie, seconded by Councillor Albert Gilbert, and passed:

Be it enacted as a By-law of the Town of Parrsboro, as follows:

Any person desiring to erect, establish, operate or maintain a public garage or filling station within the limits of the Town of Parrsboro, shall first submit the plans and specifications of the proposed garage or filling station with a description of the proposed location of the same, to the Inspector of Buildings whose duty it shall be to place the plans and specifications, with his report thereon, before the Town Council; and the Town Council may regulate or prohibit the erecting, establishing, operating or maintaining of such garage or filling station, as may be deemed best advisable, having regard to the location and architecture proposed; and no person shall commence the erection of any public garage or filling station until the plans, specifications and location have been approved by the Town Council.
