

RE WATER SHED TIMBER

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Parrsboro, that the Council do cut or cause to be cut from the water shed of the Town, approximately two hundred thousand feet of timber and that the same be milled by or on behalf of the Town;

RESOLVED FURTHER that approximately seventy-five thousand feet of the said lumber be retained by the Town for the purpose of erecting or acquiring a skating rink in the Town, and that the balance of approximately one hundred and twenty-five thousand feet be sold by the Town at the best price obtainable and that the net proceeds of the sale of the said timber be placed in a special account for Town purposes.

FURTHER RESOLVED that no tree on the said water shed be cut unless the said tree has been marked by the Department of Lands and Forests as suitable for cutting without detriment or impairment to the water shed, the said trees being therefore no longer required for the use of the said Town.
