

BY-LAW REGARDING FIXED TAXATION ON PROPERTY
OF K.B. ATKINSON, PARRSBORO

Pursuant to the Notice of Motion given at the last regular meeting of the Council, it was moved by Councillor Graham, seconded by Councillor MacAloney and passed that the following by-law be adopted and enacted by the Town of Parrsboro:

"Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Parrsboro as a By-Law, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 239A of the Town's Incorporation Act and notwithstanding any other provisions of that Act or any other Act, that the amount of the annual tax to be levied in respect of the property of KENNETH B. ATKINSON, a veteran by reason of having served in His Majesty's Forces in World War II, described in the schedule hereto, shall be SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) during such time as the said property is held by the said KENNETH B. ATKINSON under an agreement pursuant to the Veteran's Land Act (Canada) but for no longer period, provided that this By-Law shall not apply to any tax imposed in respect of personal property, water rates, sewer frontage charges, abutter's charges, or any similar tax or charge.
