

BY-LAW REGARDING FIXED TAXATION ON PROPERTY OF  
BERNARD E. BURKE, PARRSBORO, N.S.

Pursuant to the Notice of Motion given at the last regular meeting of the Town Council, it was moved by Councillor Antrim, seconded by Councillor MacAloney, and passed, that the following By-Law be adopted and enacted by the Town of Parrsboro:

"BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Parrsboro as a By-Law, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 244 of the Town's Incorporation Act, Chapt. 293, R.S.N.S. 1954 and notwithstanding any other provisions of that Act or any other Act, that the amount of the annual tax to be levied in respect of the property of BERNARD E. BURKE, a veteran by reason of having served in His Majesty's Forces in World War 11, described in the schedule hereto, shall be SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) during such time as the said property is held by the said BERNARD E. BURKE under an agreement pursuant to the Veteran's Land Act (Canada) but for no longer period, provided that this By-Law shall not apply to any tax imposed in respect of personal property, water rates, sewer frontage charges, abutter's charges, or any similar tax or charge.

SCHEDULE

That property situated on the South side of Eastern Avenue in the Town of Parrsboro, conveyed to the said Bernard E. Burke from Keith Knowlton, bounded on the southwest property of George Wilson; and on the northeast and at the rear, by property of Wordlow H. Moore; covering in area 1.9 acres; the house to be erected thereon being two stories, with full concrete basement, clapboard exterior walls, and fireproof shingles."
