

ANTI-LITTER BY-LAW

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Parrsboro that the following by-law be and the same is hereby enacted and that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Municipal Affairs with a request for his approval hereof.

1. No person shall throw any dirt, filth, or rubbish on any sidewalk, street, road, lane, or highway in the Town.
2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) and in default of such penalty may be imprisoned for a term not exceeding seven days.
3. No person shall cart or transport in any way on any street, any sand, earth, dirt, manure, hay, straw, or rubbish or any loose fluid or semi-fluid in such a manner that any portion of the same may be spilled or scattered on the street.

All by-laws heretofore passed by the Town Council pursuant to section 221 (50) of the Town's Act are hereby repealed.
