

BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF PARRSBORO TO PROVIDE A RETIRING ALLOWANCE FOR  
MISS MOLLY MORWICK, TOWN CLERK

Resolved by the Council of the Town of Parrsboro that the amendment to the following By-law is hereby enacted and that the Clerk forward two copies of it to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for his approval. (Pursuant to Section 221 (12) of Chapter 309 RSNS 1967 of the Towns Act)

Paragraph 2 to be renumbered paragraph 3.  
New Paragraph 2 to be inserted as follows:

2. This retiring allowance may be increased by an annual amount that is not greater as a proportion of the retiring allowance paid than the lessor of four per centum per annum or the percentage increase in the cost of living, as measured by Statistics Canada, for the year preceding the date of passage of the amended By-law.
