BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Town of Parrsboro that the following by-law is hereby enacted, and that the Clerk forward two copies of it to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for his approval.

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER BY-LAW

The title Clerk-Treasurer be changed to Chief Administrative Officer and that our Clerk-Treasurer be known as the Chief Administrative Officer after May 10, 1982 and is to carry out the duties of the Clerk-Treasurer as required in the Municipal Act, the Assessment Act and by all and any other Acts of the Province now in force, or which may be hereafter passed in substitution of or in amendment thereof, or in addition thereto, and also do and perform all duties imposed on the Chief Administrative Officer by any and every by-law, order or resolution of the Council, now in force or which may hereafter be in force.
