Special Collection Schedule

If your regular collection day is: Then your special collection day is:

Monday	—————>	June 11 th
Tuesday	—————>	June 18 th
Wednesday	—————>	June 25 th
Thursday	—————>	July 3 rd
Friday	—————>	July 9 th

What's Accepted?

Pile 1. Metals: refrigerators, freezers, washers & dryers, barbeque, etc.

Pile 2. Bulky items: furniture, mattresses, box spring, chairs, tables, etc.

Pile 3. Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D): doors, siding, carpet, lumber, toilets, drywall, shingles, etc. Shingles & insulation must be bagged.

NO branches or leaf & yard waste will be collected.

REMINDERS

- All materials must be placed for collection by 6:30 a.m. on **Monday** of your scheduled week.
- C&D, metals, & bulky items must be in **3 separate piles**. **Non conforming piles will not be collected.**
- C&D must be in a pile no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft.
