Construction Overview

The Municipality of the County of Cumberland is beginning the construction of the new central water supply for the Pugwash area. Once complete, this project will provide the community a clean and reliable supply of drinking water. The first phase of the project will include the installation of a water transmission pipeline from the wellfield to the Village, as well as distribution piping on the streets within the Village. The works is anticipated to begin July 25th, 2016 and substantially completed by March 31, 2017. The transmission watermain will travel along Murray Rd, Pleasure Cove Rd and Highway No. 6 to Village core. The distribution piping will include all streets within the Village core. As part of the construction, water service laterals will be installed to the provincial road right-of-way boundary at all occupied properties along the transmission and distribution piping for future connection by the property owner.

Construction of subsequent phases of the project, include a water treatment facility at the wellfield and a water storage tank; are anticipated to occur in 2017. The water supply system is to fully be operational by December 2017. Property owners will be permitted to make their connection to the installed water service lateral at the right-of-way boundary in the fall of 2017.

What to Expect

Dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction. We are committed to providing a work site that is safe and orderly. The Contractor will take every precaution to minimize interruptions to the everyday life of your family and/or operation of your business, but as you can appreciate, there may be some inconvenience during the course of the operation of the work, such as delays and traffic detours when travelling through the construction zone. Access to driveways in the immediate vicinity of the construction work may be disrupted for a brief periods, the contractor will provide residents notification in advance of this occurrence. We would like to thank you for your patience and co-operation.

Construction Work Hours

Working hours are generally 7:00am to 7:00pm. It should be noted that the Contractor might choose to work longer hours and weekends if required to complete the work.
