Description

Summer Parks Technicians are responsible for assisting in the maintenance of facilities and parks in the community of Parrsboro. This position will ensure the Municipality’s facilities, playing fields, parks and open spaces are maintained to the highest standards, to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all our participants, visitors, and customers.

These positions report to the Parrsboro Operations Supervisor.

- Ability to work efficiently in a team environment as well as independently.
- Knowledge in safely using and understanding the operation of relevant equipment and tools utilized as part of the daily work; including but not limited to tractors, mowers, and power tools.
