The construction and delivery (or build in-situ) of a building code compliant two room accessible toilet building which contains one accessible toilet in each room. Each toilet room shall have a separate entrance. Each of the toilet rooms shall also be equipped with a sink, mirror, a window and lights inside and outside over the door. The building is expected to be placed on blocks or screw piles. The placement of blocks or screw piles will be undertaken by others. The building does not need to be insulated. Connection of Black/Gray water to a holding tank will also be undertaken by others. Location: Glooscap Campground and RV Park, Parrsboro, NS. A drawing of the planned build must be provided prior to contract award.

* Price to include delivery of building or materials to location as the case may be.

* Bidder must supply a certificate of good standing with the Worker Compensation Board of Nova Scotia and a valid insurance certificate showing at least \$2,000,000.00 liability with the Municipality of the County of Cumberland named under additional insured prior to the award of work.
