Overview

In addition to water distribution, this position is responsible for driving and operating mobile equipment used in the performance of all municipal transportation related activities, including snow removal, materials handling, repairs and maintenance of water treatment and distribution and wastewater collection facilities, as well as well as, other tasks that address the needs of citizens in the delivery of public services.

This position reports to the Parrsboro Operations Supervisor

Position Responsibilities

- a) Drive and operate mobile equipment including trucks, backhoes, loaders and graders to excavate, move, load and grade earth, rock, gravel, snow, ice or other materials to provide repairs and maintenance that address the needs of citizens in the delivery of public works, water and sewer utilities;
- b) Vehicle and equipment operational checks and minor maintenance are performed in a consistent manner and according to internal departmental and other standards
- c) Conduct pre-operational checks on equipment and clean, lubricate and refill equipment and provide minor maintenance on equipment;
- d) Make recommendations and execute facility improvements, maintenance, preventative maintenance and upgrades to facilities as well as any related equipment;

- e) Support the operation of the Water Distribution System to ensure compliance with Nova Scotia, Federal and Municipal water quality guidelines and regulations;
- f) Perform inspections, repairs, replacements, new installations, and maintenance of the Water Distribution System. Collaborate with the ODRC and assist the Public Works Supervisor to identify labour, materials, and equipment and timing resources to carry out necessary activities;
- g) Maintain data and testing records for the water utility distribution system as required by regulators.
- h) Perform other reasonably related duties as assigned, including assuming Overall Direct Responsible Charge (ODRC) designation subject to appropriate training and certification and conditions and articles of the current collective agreement;
- i) Perform work outside regular working hours and during inclement weather conditions to provide repairs and maintenance to services in response to emergency situations including alarms during off hours and/or non-scheduled workdays;
- j) Act as a labourer at street, sidewalk, water treatment and distribution and wastewater collection and treatment jobsites, and other public works jobsites;
- k) Perform traffic control;
- l) Health and safety – acts with others inside and outside the team to implement and act in accord with effective health and safety plans.

Must possess a valid Nova Scotia Class 3 Driver's Licence with Air Brake designation (or prepared to obtain)

Certification as Water Distribution Operator Level 1 (or prepared to obtain)

WHIMS, First Aid, Traffic Control Person, Fire Extinguisher use, Defensive Driving, Excavation Safety, Fall Restraint, Temporary Workplace Signer, Workplace Inspections, Due Diligence, Lockout and Confined Space and Advanced Incident Investigation certification required (or willing to obtain within 12 months or as training available)
