BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Springhill, Nova Scotia, under the authority of Section 221 of the Towns Act, being Chapter 309 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1967, with particular reference to Clause (12) of the said section, that the following attached By-Law in reference to a pension for Town Employee, Kenneth Terris, become part of the By-Laws of the Town of Springhill.

TOWN OF SPRINGHILL

BY-LAW

RE: PENSION FOR KENNETH TERRIS

1. The Town of Springhill may provide a pension to KENNETH TERRIS, for many years Superintendent of Streets and Water for the said Town, not exceeding Twenty-six hundred Dollars per year, during the remainder of his natural life to commence on his retirement from the employ of the Town and to be paid from the current revenues of the Town.

2. All payments made by the Town pursuant to this by-law shall be deemed to be amounts required for the ordinary lawful purposes of the Town.
